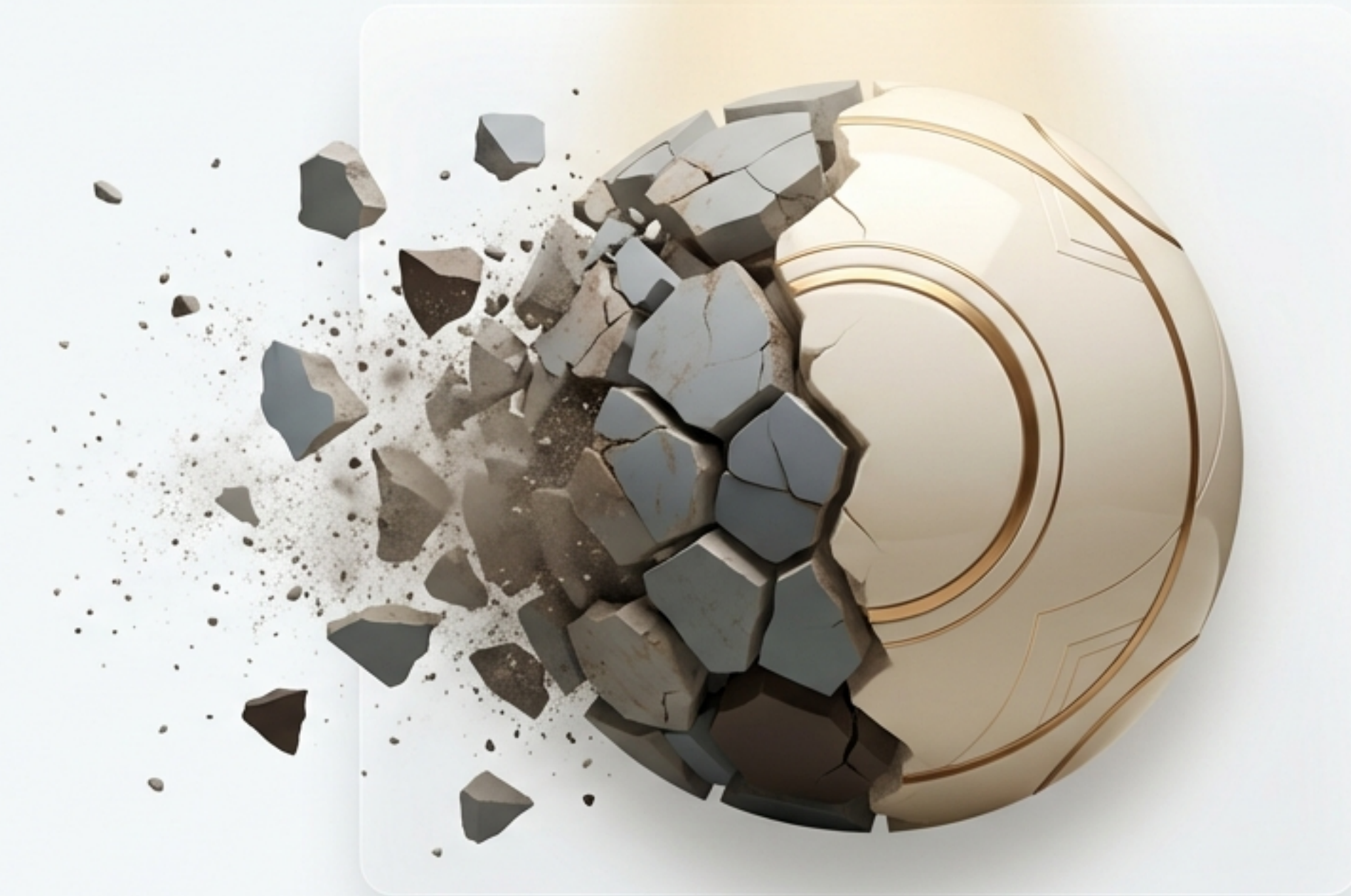


Spiritual Atheism or Divine Truth?

Material Atheism:

The Creator is distinct and separate from His creation. The universe has an absolute beginning, aligning with modern astrophysics (Big Bang).

By maintaining that current suffering is punishment for a past life, Karma inherently blames the victim. It normalizes oppression, poverty, and disease as deserved punishment.

Focused mental vibrations and energy can manifest physical wealth and alter reality.

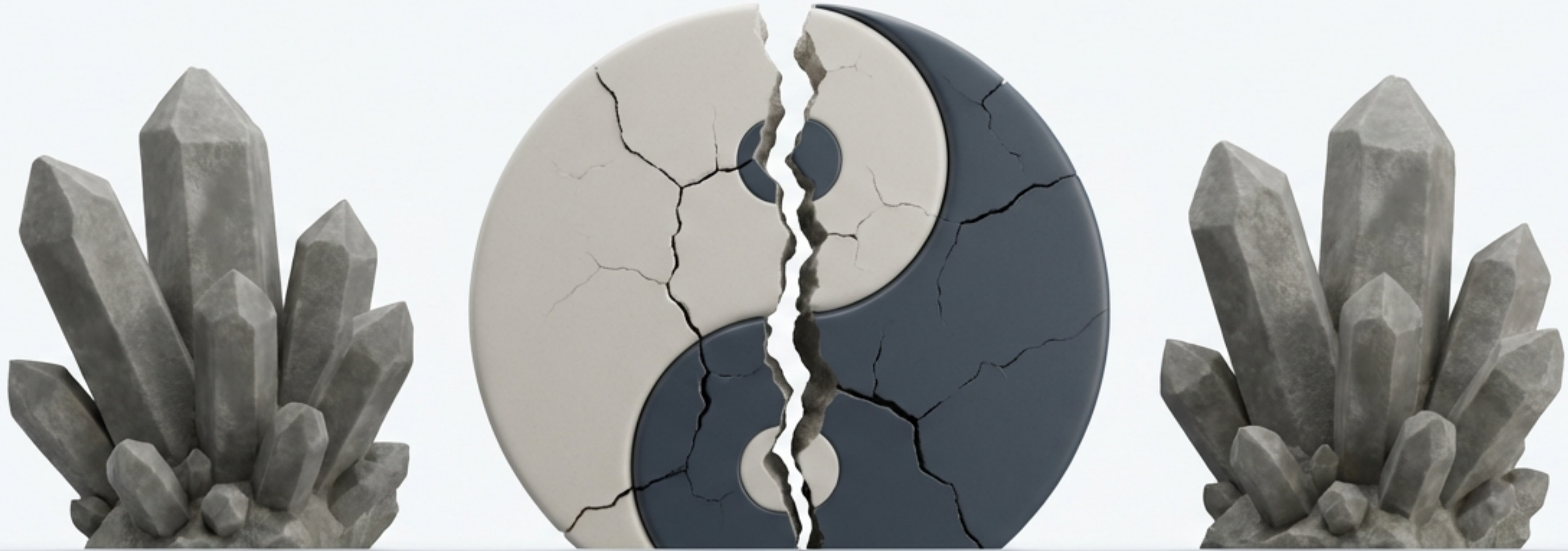
The Physics Rebuttal

The Fatal Flaws of Macrobiotics & Energy Healing

Buddhist View

Existence is inherently evil and full of suffering. The goal is to escape existence entirely through monastic isolation.

Islamic View

We exist in a realm of moral testing (Takleef). Friction, challenges, and free will are necessary for moral growth. Without the capacity for struggle, there is no civilization, no charity, and no ultimate triumph. Escapism is a rejection of humanity's purpose.



The Religion of Fitrah (Natural Disposition)



Fitrah: The innate, universal human instinct that recognizes a single Creator, especially apparent in moments of extreme crisis.

Intellect: The logical necessity of a First Cause; the universe could not create itself from nothing.

The Cosmos: The profound mathematical fine-tuning and intelligent design of the universe.

Revelation: The historical and unbroken chain of Prophets bringing the identical message of Monotheism.
