The Search for Original Truth

The Paradox of Pantheism

The Logic of Monotheism

Illusion of Karma vs. Divine Justice



Infinite reincarnation lacks Vedic evidence. Instead, the Rig Veda promises **ultimate accountability**: a single life followed by Paradise or **punishment**. This aligns perfectly with **Islam's logical concept of ultimate divine justice**.

The Equality of Mankind

Karma philosophically justifies the caste system and human suffering. Islam shatters this illusion. All humans are born innocent and equal. True nobility stems only from piety and righteous actions, not birthright.
