if they wish to


accept Islam

Those who desire to convert to Islam but have concerns about their immediate environment can embrace Islam privately until a more suitable situation arises that allows them to openly practice and express their beliefs.

It is advisable to accept Islam promptly, yet it is not obligatory to disclose this decision to those around you or publicize it if doing so could pose harm. It is essential to prioritize personal safety and well-being.

Additionally, upon embracing Islam, you become part of a broader brotherhood with fellow Muslims. Seeking assistance and counsel from the leader of a mosque



or the Islamic center in your country is encouraged, as they are pleased to provide support and guidance.
